1. Consideration and possible action to consent to the Mayor's renewal and continuation of the declaration of a local disaster under Section 418.108 of the Texas Government Code.

An emergency or urgent public necessity exists because there is an immediate need to take action to address the unforeseen and imminent threat to public health and safety resulting from Brazos River flood event.

The City Council may recess into executive session for some or all of the discussion of these items as permitted under section 551.071(2) (consultation with the City's attorney) and section 551.076 (security personnel or devices) of Chapter 551 of the Texas Government Code.
