

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 2, ARTICLE IV, DIVISION 2 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF WEST COLUMBIA, TEXAS, BY AMENDING SECTION 2-232 ENTITLED "RESIDENCE" TO PROVIDE THAT THERE IS NO RESIDENCE REQUIREMENT FOR A CITY MANAGER; PROVIDING FOR THE REPEAL OF ANY AND ALL KINDS OF ORDINANCES, REGULATIONS, RULES OR POLICIES WHICH ARE IN ANY MANNER INCONSISTENT OR IN CONFLICT WITH THIS ORDINANCE; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL, CITY OF WEST COLUMBIA, TEXAS:

Section One

Chapter 2, Article IV, Division 2, Section 2-232 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of West Columbia, Texas, shall be and is hereby amended to read as follows:

Sec. 2-232. Residence.

The City Manager is not required to meet any residency qualifications.

Section Two

It is hereby declared to be the intention of the City Council that the several provisions of this ordinance are severable, and if any court of competent jurisdiction enters a final order which holds that any section, sub-section, sentence, clause, phrase, or other portion of this ordinance is invalid, illegal, or otherwise unenforceable, then any such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct and independent provision, and any such ruling shall not affect any other provision of this ordinance which are not specifically designated as being illegal, invalid or unenforceable.

Section Three

Any rules, ordinances, police regulations, resolutions, and/or policies of the City of West Columbia, whether written, or otherwise, which are in any manner in conflict with or inconsistent with this ordinance, shall be and are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict and/or inconsistency.

Section Four

This ordinance shall be effective and applicable immediately from and after the date of its passage and approval by the City Council of the City of West Columbia.
