AN ORDINANCE FOR THE CITY OF WEST COLUMBIA, TEXAS, PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 18 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY, LAY AMENDED PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 18 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY, DESIGNATING AS A NO-PARKING ZONE THE EAST SIDE OF DAMON DRIVE FROM ITS INTERSECTION WITH HIGHWAY 35 TO ITS INTERSECTION WITH CRAWFORD LANE; AND DESIGNATING FOR THE PLACEMENT OF STOP SIGNS SWEENEY STREET IN BOTH DIRECTIONS AT ITS INTERSECTION WITH SOUTH STREET, SWEENEY STREET AT ITS INTERSECTION WITH SOUTH 14TH STREET, SOUTH STREET IN BOTH DIRECTIONS AT ITS INTERSECTION WITH JIM HOGG; JIM HOGG AT ITS INTERSECTION WITH SOUTH 14TH STREET; AND SOUTH STREET AT ITS INTERSECTION WITH GULF DRIVE; AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE CITY MANAGER TO ERECT APPROPRIATE SIGNS REGARDING THESE REGULATIONS; PROVIDING FOR THE REPEAL OF ALL CODE PROVISIONS, ORDINANCES, RESOLUTIONS, AND/OR INFORMAL POLICIES OF THE CITY OF WEST COLUMBIA TO THE EXTENT THAT THEY ARE INCONSISTENT OR IN CONFLICT WITH THIS ORDINANCE; CONTAINING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; PROVIDING THAT THE VIOLATION OF THIS ORDINANCE SHALL CONSTITUTE AN OFFENSE PUNISHABLE BY A FINE OF NO MORE THAN TWO HUNDRED AND 00/100'S (\$200.00); AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WEST COLUMBIA, TEXAS:

Section One

The City hereby designates, pursuant to Section 18-160, 18-161 and 18-164 of the Code of Ordinances of the City as to no stopping, standing or parking zone, the following:

- [1] the East side of Damon Drive from its intersection with State Highway 35 and continuing to the point of its intersection with Crawford Lane.

The list of streets on which parking is prohibited, and which is on file with the City Secretary pursuant to section 18-164 of the Code of Ordinances, shall be amended to include the areas designated above.

Section Two

The City hereby designates, pursuant to section 18-101 of the Code of Ordinances of the City, as a stop intersection, the following:

- [1] Sweeny Street in both directions at its intersection with South Street;
- [2] Sweeny Street at its intersection with South 14th Street;
- [3] South Street in both directions at its intersection with Jim Hogg;
- [4] Jim Hogg at its intersection with South 14th Street; and
- [5] South Street at its intersection with Gulf Drive.

The list of stop intersections, which is on file with the City Secretary pursuant section 18-101 of the Code of Ordinances, shall be amended to include the intersections designated above. To the extent that all or any portion of the intersections designated above as stop intersections have previously been designated as yield intersections, those designations as yield intersections shall be and are hereby repealed.

Section Three

Failure to observe and obey the traffic regulations adopted above and the signs erected pursuant to this ordinance shall constitute a misdemeanor, and shall be punishable by a fine of no more than Two Hundred and 00/100's Dollars (\$200.00).

Section Four

Any and all code provisions, rules, ordinances, police regulations, resolutions, and/or informal policies of the City of West Columbia, whether written, or otherwise, which are in any manner in conflict with or inconsistent with this ordinance, shall be and are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict and/or inconsistency.


Section Five

It is hereby declared to be the intention of the City Council that the several provisions of this ordinance are severable, and if any court of competent jurisdiction enters a final order which holds that any section, sub-section, sentence, clause, phrase, or other portion of this ordinance is invalid, illegal, or otherwise unenforceable, then any such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct and independent provision, and any such ruling shall not affect any provision of this ordinance which are not specifically designated as being illegal, invalid or unenforceable.

Section Six


This ordinance shall be effective and applicable immediately from and after the date of its passage and approval by the City Council and the City of West Columbia, and the publication of its caption as provided by law.
