

ORDINANCE NO: 567

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING DIVISION 2 ENTITLED "PARK COMMISSION" OF ARTICLE III ENTITLED "BOARDS, COMMITTEES AND COMMISSIONS" OF CHAPTER 2 ENTITLED "ADMINISTRATION" OF THE ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF WEST COLUMBIA TEXAS BY RENAMING THE PARKS COMMISSION TO BE THE PARKS AND RECREATION BOARD AND OTHERWISE BY RESTRUCTURING AND RESTATING THE COMPOSITION; ORGANIZATION AND DUTIES OF THAT BOARD; CONTAINING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; PROVIDING FOR THE REPEAL OF ANY AND ALL ORDINANCES, REGULATIONS, RULES OR POLICIES WHICH ARE IN ANY MANNER INCONSISTENT OR IN CONFLICT WITH THIS ORDINANCE; AND PROVIDING AND EFFECTIVE DATE.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL CITY OF WEST COLUMBIA, TEXAS:

**Section One**

Division 2 of Article III of Chapter 2 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of West Columbia, Texas, entitled "Parks Commission" shall be and is hereby amended to read as follows:

**DIVISION 2. PARKS AND RECREATION BOARD**

**Sec. 2-161. Established; membership.**

There is hereby established a Parks and Recreation Board for the City. This board shall consist of ten (10) persons serving without pay who shall be appointed by the Mayor, with the consent of the City Council. The City Secretary shall be an ex officio member of the board and record the minutes and serve as a liaison between the board and the City.


**Section Three**

Any rules, ordinances, police regulations, resolutions, and/or policies of the City of West Columbia, whether written, or otherwise, which are in any manner in conflict with or inconsistent with this ordinance, shall be and are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict and/or inconsistency.


**Section Four**
